## School Dress Code Policy 2017-2018



### Tops

**A. Collared, polo style, button down, or t-shirt**

**B. Sweatshirts/Outerwear**

- Sweatshirts and hoodies worn during the school day can be pullover or zip-up with crew neck or hoodie type
- Hoods from a hoodie or jacket may not be worn on the head at any time during the school day

*\*Inappropriate tops include, but are not limited to, exposure of undershirt, midriff, deep v-neck, low-cut tops, exposed underarms. No sleeveless garments, or any article of clothing that is tight fitting or overly baggy.*

### Bottoms

**A. Pants/Jeans**

- Must be in good repair: no holes or fraying
- Hemmed, and must be worn properly at the waist
- No leather, suede, vinyl, nylon, spandex, knit or shiny material

**B. Shorts, skirts, dresses, skorts**

- Must have a hem and must be mid-thigh when standing.
- No athletic or gym shorts

*\*Inappropriate bottoms include, but are not limited to, overalls, coveralls, wind or jogging pants, sweat pants, pajamas, stretch pants, yoga pants, leggings, jeggings, or any article of clothing that is tight fitting or overly baggy.*

### Shoes

- Shoes with lacing holes must have laces present and tied
- Heels may not be higher than 2"
- No house slippers, sandals without a back, athletic sandals, flip-flops, rubber sandals, Crocs, or Heelies
- All shoes must have a back or heel strap

### Jewelry/Hair

- Pierced jewelry is limited to ears only
- No inappropriate collars, bracelets or wrist bands (leather, spiked or other sharp edges or inappropriate words)
- No hats or head coverings permitted (unless for religious beliefs and approved by administration)
- No hair styles, which in the judgment of the building administrators, disrupt the educational process.
- No sunglasses will be allowed to be worn on campus

*\*School Administration shall determine if jewelry or hair is appropriate for school. Any piece of jewelry, or hair style deemed an educational distraction by School Administration will not be allowed.*

*Inappropriate clothing not to be worn at school includes, but is not limited to: cut-offs, halters, strapless garments, spaghetti straps, open underarm shirts, tank tops, deep v-neck shirts, low-cut top shirts, crop-tops, clothes that expose undershirts, pajamas, sweat pants, boxer shorts, athletic shorts, overalls, coveralls, wind or jogging pants, stretch pants, yoga pants, leggings/jeggings, or any article of clothing that is tight fitting or overly baggy. All other general requirements of the CCISD dress code policy apply.*

**The District prohibits pictures, emblems, or writings on clothing that:**

1. Are lewd, offensive, vulgar, or obscene
2. Advertise or depict tobacco products, alcoholic beverages, drugs, or any substance prohibited under FNCF (Legal)

**The building administrators determine whether a student's dress is inappropriate and issue consequences. Repeated offenses may result in more serious disciplinary actions.**
